**DIRECTIONS TO LENHAM COMMUNITY CENTRE, GROOM WAY, LENHAM ME17 2QT**

Lenham is on the A20 between Maidstone and Ashford, about 5 miles coast-bound from M20 junction 8 and about 8 miles London-bound from M20 junction 9. Lenham also has a railway station, which is about 1 mile from the Community Centre, and regular bus services from Maidstone and Ashford.

If driving from the Maidstone direction, leave the M20 at junction 8. Follow signs for A20 Ashford. After about 5 miles turn right onto Faversham Road, entering Lenham. Bear right onto The Square, and turn left onto the Old Ashford Road then left onto Groom Way.

From Ashford, leave the M20 at junction 9. Follow signs for A20 Maidstone. After about 8 miles bear left onto the Old Ashford Road. Turn right onto Groom Way.
