

A stroll around Castle Hill

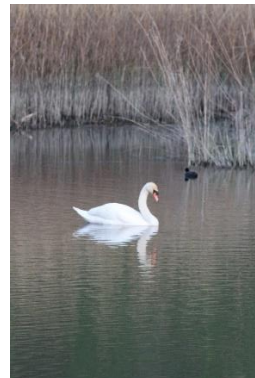
Our walk often takes us along a sunken pathway between Swancombe and Castle Hill. A lovely path slightly spoiled by litter.
